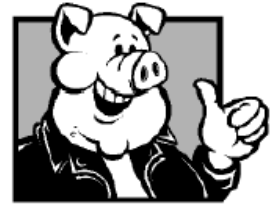

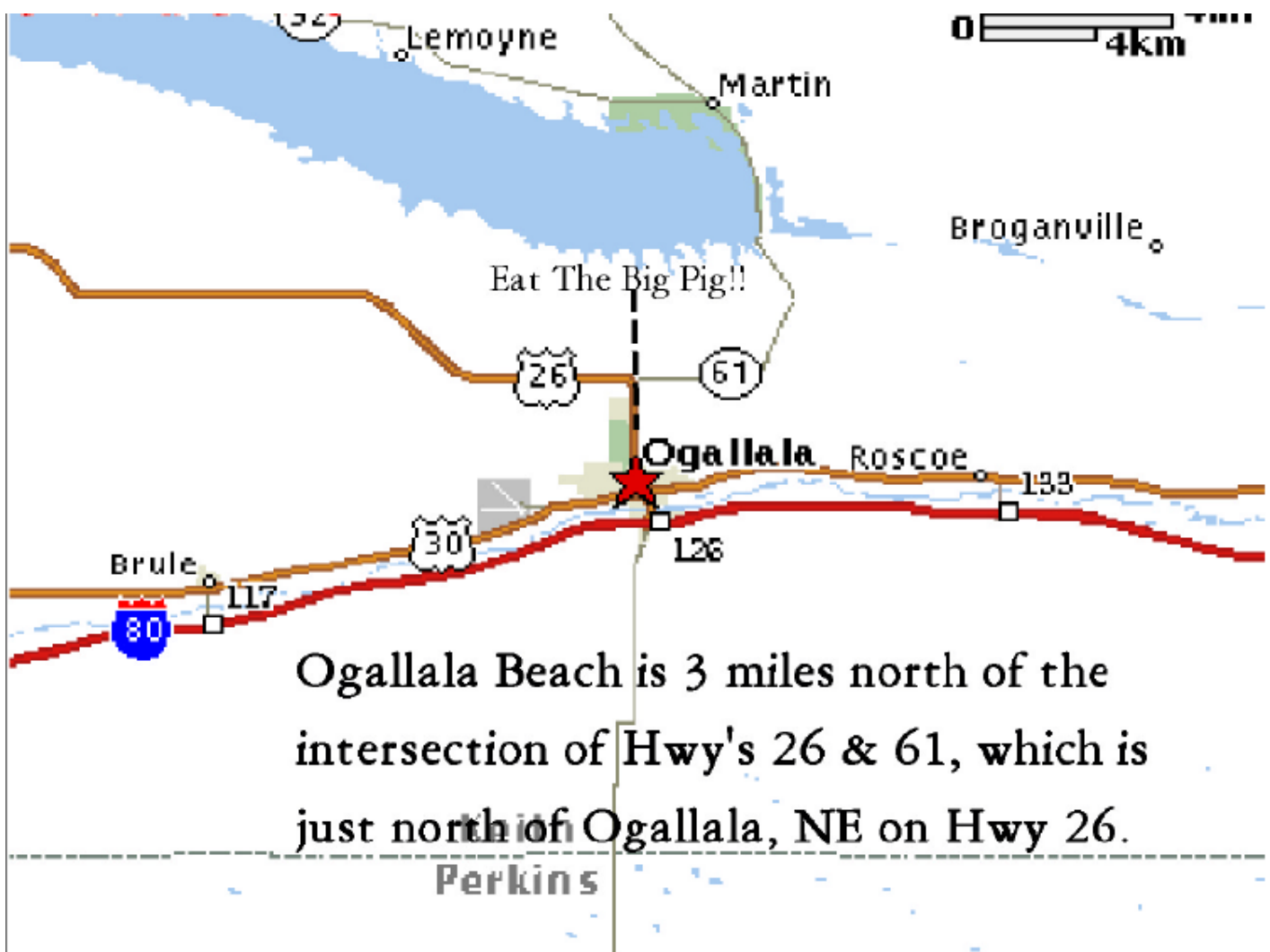

You will need a Nebraska State Park Permit for your vehicle. They are inexpensive, and available at almost any gas station/kwik-mart.

Note: Ogallala Beach is beautiful, but primitive. There are no showers, etc. at the beach. Showers are available on the east side of the lake, approx. 10 miles away. Be prepared when you come! Suggested items: Tent, Sleeping Bag or Blankets, Bug Spray, Cooler, Plenty Of Bottled Water, Sunscreen. Dehydration and Sunburn are No Fun! There are plenty of inexpensive motel rooms in Ogallala for those of you who want to attend, but don't want to rough it.
